## OVERALL RECOMMENDATIONS UPON COMPLETION OF INSPEXX TRIAL AT ... 384

The Inspexx system should be considered for approval with some conditions:

- 1. The alternative system being approved involves a two step process. Step 1 involves a wash with hot water at >=46oC. Step 2 involves immersion in the Inspexx solution at ambient temperature for 30 seconds.
  - 2. A process flow diagram showing the position of all sterilisers along the slaughter line
- 3. Revised SOPs for knife disinfection, including a contingency plan to switch to 82 degrees Centigrade water should the need arise.
- 4. Written procedure detailing the daily verification checks which will be performed on the system.
- 5. Written procedure detailing an enhanced monitoring programme which will ensure all cutting tools being disinfected with the alternate sterilisation system are subject to microbiological checks over a period of time. The person responsible for monitoring must be specified. Testing for TVC is sufficient. The programme can be scaled down over time upon receipt of satisfactory results.
