



Close-out December 2024 Pest Report

(6th follow-up pest report of November 2019)

1.1 Tomato brown rugose fruit virus (ToBRFV) present in the Netherlands

1.2 Executive summary

This pest report concerns a change of pest status for the Netherlands. In view of a change of EU regulation for ToBRFV as regulated non quarantine pest as of 1 January 2025, the NPPO of the Netherlands will no longer aim at eradicating ToBRFV as part of fruit production sites. At the same time official phytosanitary safeguards will remain in place for ensuring pest freedom of seeds and young plants.

Since 2019 in total 82 fruit production locations were confirmed positive for ToBRFV. Eradication has been fully successful at 39 locations. At 4 locations the virus has been eradicated but was again detected. Measures will be stopped for all fruit productions sites.
