First finding of *Cryptostroma corticale* (fungus) in firewood of *Acer pseudoplatanus.*

Introduction

This report concerns the first official finding of *Cryptostroma corticale* in the Netherlands on firewood of a tree of *Acer pseudoplatanus* which was cut down in September 2013. The organism is not listed as a harmful organism in the EU directive 2000/29/EC and is not listed on the EPPO lists. A preliminary risk analysis has been completed (see attached). The fungus is present in the EU including nearby countries and is naturally transmitted by airborne spores. No follow-up measures are taken.
