 - Session 1: Disease occurrence and management
 - Session 2: Understanding the pathogen
 - Session 3: Host resistance and breeding
- Participants can indicate if they prefer an oral or a poster presentation. When you select an oral presentation, you may be asked to present in a different session, or to present a poster.
- Participants have to submit an **author list**, **affiliation list**, and a **short abstract** (max. 250 words) for their presentation upon registration (see screenshot).
- Author names, author affiliations and abstracts will be made available to the workshop participants and on the workshop website.

ORAL PRESENTATIONS

- In each of the three sessions, four oral presentations will be given.
- For each oral presentation, 30 minutes are available (20 minutes presentation and 10 minutes questions).
- Presenters need to provide a presentation in Microsoft PowerPoint format (*.pptx) that can be run from a Microsoft Windows computer.
- Presenters can choose if they want to make their slides available online on the workshop website as Acrobat pdf file after the workshop.
- When preparing your presentation, please take the time limitations. In general, each slide represents a single minute of presentation time.

POSTER PRESENTATION

- Posters should be in either A1 (59,4 x 84,1 cm) to A0 (118,9 x 84,1 cm) format.
- Posters are preferably in “portrait” orientation.
- Poster boards and thumbtacks will be provided.
- Presenters receive a poster board number for their poster upon registration at the meeting (26 June).
- On Wednesday 26 June a poster session is organized from 3:30 – 5:00 pm. Presenters are asked to be present with their poster at this time.
